



SUMMER CAMP 2010



for Youth Ages 5-12

May 21st - August 9th

To qualify* you must:

- Be an adult caring for dependent children ages 5-12
- Be actively involved in either job training, vocational training, GED, technical school, college (full or part-time) or employed working at least 15 hours per week or more
- If employed, have total family income fall within the income guidelines* See Below (i.e. A family of four must earn \$58,460 in annual income or less to qualify)
- Select a Summer Camp program licensed or exempt summer camp provider (Exempt Summer Camp Providers must either have a letter of exemption from Department Early Care And Learning-DECAL or do not have to meet exemption requirements because they are considered a government entity)

The following verification documents must be submitted with your application:

- Proof of Residence
- Verification of school/training enrollment and attendance
- Verification of employment
- Verification of child's citizenship
- Verification of identification
- Summer Camp published rate from selected provider
